



Female - Junior Coaching Course

The FFA recognised Junior Coaching Course is tailored towards coaches with modest experience who wish to build on their coaching skills. This course provides a logical progression from recently conducted Grassroots courses. The course includes approximately 12 hours of theoretical and practical football coaching education.

Key areas covered during the course are as follows:

- Running a session
- Modification
- Safety

- Observation
- Junior coaching tools and resources

This is an entry level coaching licence with no prior learning or experience required. Successful attendees may progress to further coach education pathways in line with the FFA curriculum.
